

ADDITIONS TO THE FLORA OF PINDARI GLACIERS AND NEIGHBOURING LOCALITIES IN THE KUMAON HILLS, UTTAR PRADESH*

ABSTRACT

This study adds 178 taxa belonging to 66 families to the list of plants hitherto reported from Pindari Glaciers and adjoining areas.

INTRODUCTION

Pindari Glaciers have long been a source of attraction to botanists from all over the country. Their observations on the plants and vegetation of this region have resulted in a number of publications. STRACHEY's catalogue, revised and published by DUTHIE in 1906, is the oldest record on the Plants of Kumaon. STRACHEY's observations were based on a collection made jointly by him and WINTERBOTTOM. CHAMPION (1921) published a small list of plants collected by him enroute to Pindari Glaciers. RAO (1960) gave an exhaustive account of plants while making a survey of the vegetation of this region. He also included Almora, Ranikhet and Nainital in his studies. He reports 720 species of plants occurring in this area, of which 676 are Angiosperms, 4 Gymnosperms and the rest Pteridophytes. Recently SINGH AND KUMAR (1975) have added 56 plants to the Pindari Glaciers flora.

This paper makes a further contribution of about 178 taxa to the plants of this region. It is based on the collections made by : (1) the senior author from Pindari Glaciers and adjoining areas during May-June, 1972 ; (2) D. D. Awasthi in May, 1950 ; (3) Duthie in 1886, (4) Osmoston in 1932 ; (5) Bis Ram in 1933 ; (6) Parkinson in 1935; and (7) Champion (date not given). The collections made by the senior author and Awasthi are lodged in the herbarium of National Botanical Research Institute, Lucknow (LWG), and those of Duthie, Osmoston, Bis Ram, Parkinson and Champion are lodged in the herbarium of the Forest Research Institute, Dehra Dun (DD).

The study includes short description, locality or localities and field notes and vernacular names, if known for the taxa.

BERBERIDACEAE

Berberis coriarea Royle

Shrub near Dwali, 2590 m. Awasthi, 868 Vern. Moosi, Chyotar.

B. edgewarthiana C. B. Sch.

Dwali, 2590 m. Awasthi, 866. Vern. Kinmoda.

B. kumaonsis C. B. Sch.

Dhakuri hill, 2590 m. Awasthi, 761.

B. asiatica Roxb.

Shrub with spines. Fruits yellow. Flowers pale yellow very common. Jageshwar temple, Near Artola, Distt. Almora. Balapure & Pandey, 93419.

Mahonia nepalensis DC.

Syn. *Berberis nepalensis* Spring in part.

A hardy shrub with yellow flowers and leaves. Common. Khati to Dhakuri, 2438 m. Awasthi, 931, also Balapure & Pandey, 72776. Vern. Kaerua.

FUMARIACEAE

Corydalis vaginans Royle

Syn. *C. ramosa* Wall.

Herb with blue flowers. Quite common on rocks. Dhakuri to Khati, 2438 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91572, Dwali to Phurkia, along the Pindar river, Distt. Almora, 2743 m-3124 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93343, 93349 & 93362.

BRASSICACEAE (CRUCIFERAE)

Capsella bursa-pastoris (Linn.) Medic.

Herb with white flowers. Very common. Dwali to Kafni Glacier. 2743 m-3352 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93323.

Thalspi arvense Linn.

Herb with white flowers. Near Khati, 2286 m. Awasthi, 920.

T. alpestre Linn.

Herb with white flowers. Very common in moist shady places Phurkia to Pindari Glacier, 3124 m-3962 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93357.

VIOLACEAE

Viola canescens Wall.

Herb with light blue flowers. Very common in the shade of trees in moist places on the slopes of mountains. Khati to Dwali, on the bank of Pindar river, 2195 m-2743 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91590. Ranikhet, near about the town, 1900 m. Balapure & Pandey, 72722.

POLYGALACEAE

Polygala abyssinica Fresen.

Herb with pink flowers. Very common. Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93267.

CARYOPHYLLACEAE

Cerastium vulgatum Linn.

Small herb with small white flowers. Very common in moist shady places. Ranikhet 1900 m. Balapure & Pandey, 72701, Khati to Dwali, 2195 m-2743 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91596 & 91519.

Arenaria orbiculata Royle

Herb with white flowers. Very common. Dwali to Kafni Glacier, 2743 m-3352 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93316.

A. festucoides Benth.

Small herb with yellowish flowers. Growing in the shade of Dak bungalow at Dwali, 2743 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91588.

A. serpyllifolia Linn.

Caryophyllaceous herb with white flowers. Common. Between Loharkhet & Dhakuri, 1828 m.-2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91526.

HYPERICACEAE

Hypericum oblongifolium Choisy

Syn. *H. cernuum* Roxb.

Shrub with yellow flowers. Kapkot-Loharkhet (enroute to Pindari Glaciers), 1127 m-1219 m. Awasthi, 694 & Dhakuri hill, 2438 m. Awasthi, 936.

TERNSTROEMIACEAE

Eurya acuminata DC.

Shrub with white flowers. Near Khati, 2286 m. Awasthi, 912.

LINACEAE

Reinwardtia trigyna Planch

Under shrub with yellow flowers. Kapkot-Loharkhet, 1676 m. Awasthi, 691.

STERCULIACEAE

Guazuma tomentosa Kunth

A large tree. Bageshwar-Kapkot, 975 m-1066 m. Awasthi, 680.

RUTACEAE

Zanthoxylum acanthopodium DC.

Strong thorny hardy shrub with green fruits. Very common. Almora, on way to Kasar Devi; 1828 m-1981 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93244.

CELASTRACEAE

Euonymus echinatus Wall.

Small shrub with whitish yellow flowers. Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 2590 m. Awasthi, 713.

E. tingens Wall.

Small tree with yellow white, purple veined flowers. Khati to Dwali ; 2438 m.

RHAMNACEAE

Govania leptostachya DC.

Climbing shrub. Almora, 1828 m. Awasthi, 1933.

Helinus lanceolatus Brandis

Climbing shrub. Bageshwar-Kapkot, 1066 m. Awasthi, 675.

Rhamnus virgatus Roxb.

A spinous shrub. Dwali, 2590 m. Awasthi, 847. Vern. Chandkhala.

AMPELIDACEAE

Parthenocissus semicordata Planch.

Syn. *Vitis himalayana* Brand. var. *semicordata* Wall.

Large climber with small green buds. Quite common. Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 2590 m-2743 m enroute Pindari Glaciers, Awasthi. Also Dhakuri to Khati, 914 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91537 & 91557.

Vitis lanata Roxb.

Climbing over high trees. Flowers yellow green in large panicles. Takula-Bageshwar, 1371 m. Awasthi, 641.

V. parvifolia Roxb.

Syn. *V. flexuosa* Thunb. var. *parvifolia* Gegnep.

Climber, flowers green. Near Kapkot, 1067 m. Awasthi, 671.

SAPINDACEAE

Acer oblongum Wall.

Large tree with winged fruits, Kapkot-Loharkhet, 1219 m. Awasthi, 685.

A. villosum Wall. var. **thomsonii**

A tree. Dhakuri-Khathi, 2133 m. Awasthi, 789, Vern. Khamia.

A. caesium Wall.

Very large tree with winged fruits. Very common and dominant species in the forest. Khati to Dwali, on the bank of Pindar river. Balapure & Pandey, 93306 & 93351.

CORIARIACEAE

Coriaria nepalensis Wall.

Scandant shrub. Flowers white. Near Bassauli, Takula, 1371 m. Awasthi 585. Also Ranikhet. Balapure & Pandey, 72744 & 72726.

PAPILIONACEAE

Caragana nubigena Bunge

Syn. *C. crassicaulis* Benth. ex Baker

Shrub with yellow flowers. Near Pindari Glaciers, 3784 m. Awasthi, 906. Vern. Lachenchu.

Desmodium laburnifolium DC.

Shrub with white flowers. Askot, 1219 m. Awasthi, 1947.

Indigofera dosua Buch-Ham.

Shrub with pink flowers. Very common. Jageshwar temple near Artola. Almora Distt. 1828 m. Almora, 1981 m. Awasthi, 559. Also Balapure & Pandey, 93400.

I. atropurpurea Buch.-Ham.

Syn. *I. pulchella* Roxb.

Shrub with bright pink flowers. Near Khati, 2316 m. Awasthi, 815.

Lespedeza stenocarpa Maxim

Syn. *L. microcarpa* Baker

Shrub with deep red flowers. Takula hill. Awasthi, 610.

Tephrosia candida DC.

A low shrub with reddish or white flowers. Almora, Chalthi river, 1219 m. Awasthi, 605 & 2018.

Vicia tenera Grah.

Herb with pink flowers. Takula hill. Awasthi, 605.

V. hirsuta (Linn.) Gray

Herb with small pods. Common. Dhakuri to Khati, 2438-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91575.

Alysicarpus monilifer DC.

Herb. Common. Jageshwar temple, Artola, 1828 m, Almora. Balapure & Pandey, 93401.

CAESALPINIACEAE

Cassia laevigata Willd.

Bageshwar-Kapkot, 975 m-1066 m. Awasthi, 662.

MIMOSACEAE

Acacia decurrens Willd.

Almora, 1981 m. Hira Lal, 5200.

Albizia stipulata Boiv.

Very large tree with white flowers. Common in the forest. Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93265; Also Bageshwar to Kapkot 1005 m. Awasthi 655; also Almora. Balapure & Pandey, 93273 & 93264.

ROSACEAE

Duchesnea indica Focke

Syn. *Fragaria indica* Andr.

Soft silky herb with yellow flowers. Khati, 2316 m. Awasthi, 810.

Potentilla argyrophylla Wall. ex Lehm. var. **leucochroa**

Herb with yellow flowers. Pindari Glaciers, Bis Ram, 2350 (DD Herb.)

Prunus domestica Linn.

Syn. *P. communis* Hudson.

Small tree with white flowers. Takula, 1310 m. Awasthi, 620 and also Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 2590 m. Awasthi, 754. Vern. Tumdiya Nashpati. Cultivated.

P. armeniaca Linn.

Large tree with rounded woolly fruits. Cultivated. Vern. Khubani, Pulma. Almora, on way to Kasar Devi, 1828 m-1981 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93218.

Pyrus lanata D. Don

Tree with white flowers. Dhakuri hill, 2590 m. Awasthi, 782.

Rosa moschata Mill.

Large thorny shrub with beautiful pink flowers. Very common. Takula-Bageshwar, 1219 m. Awasthi, 631. Also Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93248. Dhakuri to Khati, 2438 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91547.

Rubus ellipticus Smith

Large shrub with white flowers. Almora, 1985 m. Awasthi, 534. Vern. Hissalu.

R. macilentus Camb.

Trailing shrub with white flowers. Common. Jageshwar temple, Artola, Almora Distt. 1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93391.

R. biflorus Buch.-Ham. ex Smith

A straggling shrub with spinescent stem. Flowers white. Common. Dhakuri to Khati, 2438 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91574.

SAXIFRAGACEAE

Saxifraga pulvinaria H. Sm.

Syn. *S. imbricata* Royle

Herb with whitish flowers. Very common. Phurkia to Pindari Glaciers, along the bank of Pindar river, 3124 m-3962 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93360. Furkia, 3352 m. Awasthi, without no.

S. ligulata Wall.

Syn. *Bergenia ligulata* Engl.

Herb. Flowers white or rose purplish, near Dwali, 2438 m-2590 m. Awasthi, 872. Also Almora, 1984 m. Awasthi, 543. Vern. Sadbadua.

S. oppositifolia Linn.

Herb with white flowers, very common. Near Pindari Glaciers, 3479 m. Awasthi, 882. Also Dwali to Phurkia along Pindar river 2743 m -3124 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93344.

Hydrangea macrophylla Ser.

Trailing shrub. Common. Jageshwar temple near Artola, Almora Distt. 1828 m. Cultivated. Balapure & Pandey, 93391.

CRASSULACEAE

Sedum rosulatum Edgew.

Succulent herb with white flowers. Dhakuri, 2590 m-2743 m. Awasthi, 726. Also Khati-Dwali, 2438 m-2590 m. Awasthi, 853.

S. linearifolium Royle

Syn. *S. trifidum* Wall.

Succulent herb with pale pink flowers. Dr. Rao's record is from Khati to Dhakuri
Pass while our record is from Kafni Glacier. Bis Ram (D D Herb.) date 11.10.1933.

HALORAGACEAE

Callitriche stagnalis Scop.

Spreading herb. Common near the lake in a ditch. Bhimtal lake, Nainital,
1400 m. Balapure & Pandey, 72759

Oenothera rosea Ait.

Herb with pink flowers. Takula-Bageshwar, 1219 m. Awasthi, 623.

UMBELLIFERAE

Bupleurum falcatum Linn.

Perennial herb with yellow flowers. Takula hill, 2133 m. Awasthi, 600.

Vicatia multifolia C. B. Cl.

Herb. Near Khati, 2316 m., Awasthi, 808.

V. millefolia (Klotzsch.) C. B. Cl.

Herb with yellow flowers. Rare. Between Loharkhet & Dhakuri. Balapure
& Pandey, 91523.

V. conifolia DC.

Herb with yellow flowers. Dwali, 2743 m on the main route to Pindari glaciers.
Bis Ram (DD Herb.), 12.6.1933.

CORNACEAE

Cornus capitata Wall.

Large shrub with pale yellow flowers. Takula, 1676 m. Awasthi, 608.

C. macrophylla Wall.

Large tree. Takula-Bageshwar, 1371 m. Awasthi, 647.

ALANGIACEAE

Alangium chinensis (Lour.) Merrill

Shrub with white flowers. Takula, 1828 m. Awasthi, 615.

V. colebrookianum Wall

Large spreading shrub with white flowers. Loharkhet to Dhakuri, 2286m-2438
m. Awasthi, 752.

V. erubescens Wall.

Tree with white flowers. Very common. Between Loharkhet and Dhakuri, 2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91507.

V. nervosum D. Don.

Tree with greenish fruit. Leaves scented like "Curry leaf." Very common. Dwali to Kafni, 2743 m-3352 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93335.

RUBIACEAE

Uncaria pilosa Roxb.

Climbing shrub. Bageshwar-Kapkot, 1005 m. Awasthi, 658.

Wendlandia puberula DC.

Small shrub. Flowers white. Near Kapkot, 1066 m. Awasthi, 942.

VALERIANACEAE

Valeriana pyrolaefolia Decaisne

Herb with violet flowers. Very common. Near Furkia, 3048 m. Also Dwali to Phurkia, along Pindar river, 2743 m-3124 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93341 & 93348.

COMPOSITAE

Cnicus argyranthus Cl.

Herb with pinkish heads. Very common. Takula-Bageshwar, 1219 m-1371 m. Awasthi, 629. Also Jageshwar temple near Artola, Almora, 1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93407.

Sonchus brachyotes DC.

Syn. *S. arvensis* auct. non Linn.

Herb with yellow heads. Almora-Takula, 1676 m. Awasthi, 575.

Inula grandiflora Willd.

Shrub with yellow heads. Dwali Pindari V. 2743 m. Collector's name and number not clear (DD Herb.).

Aster peduncularis Wall. ex Nees

Syn. *A. asperulus* Nees

Herb with purple flowers. Furkia, 3225 m. Bis Ram No. Nil (DD Herb.)

A. multiradiatus Bth.

Herb. Kafni, 3300 m. Bis Ram (DD. Herb.)

Senecio nudicaulis Buch.-Ham.

Herb with yellow heads. Almora-Takula, 1676 m. Awasthi, 565.

S. chrysanthemoides DC.

Herb with yellow heads. Kafni, 3300 m. Bis Ram No. Nil. 11.10.1933 (DD Herb.)

Lactuca dissecta D. Don

Herb with pale blue flowers. Takula-Bageshwar. 1219 m-1371 m. Awasthi, 629.

Cicerbita macrorhiza (Royle) Beauv.

Syn. *Lactuca macrorhiza* Hook. f.

Herb with bluish flowers. Kafni 3300 m. No. Nil., 11.10.1933. Bis Ram (DD Herb.)

Youngia japonica DC.

Syn. *Crepis japonica* Benth.

Herb with small yellow heads. Very common in shade of trees in moist places. Khati to Dwali on the bank of Pindar river 2133 m-2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91589.

Erigeron alpinus Linn.

Herb with white heads. Very common. Dhakuri to Khati, 2438 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91569.

CAMPANULACEAE

Campanula cashmiriana Royle

Herb with bright blue flowers. Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 2286 m-2438 m. Awasthi, 747.

ERICACEAE

Lyonia ovalifolia (Wall.) Drude

Syn. *Pieris ovalifolia* D. Don

Small tree with white flowers. On way to Takula, Almora, 1676 m. Awasthi, 581. Also Donagiri hills, Almora B. Devi, 42026.

Rhododendron barbatum Wall.

Tree in fruiting state. Very common. Near Furkia, 3048 m. Awasthi, 876. Also on Dhakuri hill 2743 m. Awasthi, 729. Also Furkia to Pindari Glaciers, along the bank of Pindar river, 3124 m-3962 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93366.

PRIMULACEAE

Primula geranifolia Hook. f.

Herb. Khati-Dwali, 2133 m-2438 m. Awasthi, 854.

P. edgeworthii Pax.

Near Furkia 3048 m. Awasthi, 893. Also Dhakuri, 2743 m-2895 m. Awasthi, 771.

P. floribunda Wall.

Herb with blue flowers. Balapure & Pandey, 93346. Very common. Dwali to Furkia, 2743 m.-3124 m. Also Khati to Dwali, on the bank of Pindar river, 2133 m-2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93317.

P. bracteata Craib.

Herb with white flowers. Very common. Dwali to Furkia along the Pindar river, 2743 m-3124 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93345.

Androsace lanuginosa Wall.

Small herb with white flowers. Very common. Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 1828 m-2438 m Hira Lal, Also Dwali to Kafni glacier, 2743 m-3352 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93309.

A. rotundifolia Hardwick.

Herb with pinkish flowers in umbels. Very common in the shade of trees in moist

places. Khati to Dwali, on the bank of Pindar river, 2133 m-2438 m., Balapure & Pandey, 91581.

A. saxifragaefolia Bunge

Herb. Common. Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93296.

MYRSINACEAE

Maesa indica (Roxb.) Wall.

Large shrub with white flowers. Near Bageshwar, 1005 m. Awasthi, 568.

SYMPLOCACEAE

Symplocos ramosissima Wall.

A shrub. Kathi, 2286 m. C. E. Parkinson, 12 June, 1935 (DD Herb.)

OLEACEAE

Jasminum humile Linn.

Shrub with beautiful yellow flowers. Common on the slope of mountain in the shade of trees. Khati to Dwali, 2438 m. Awasthi, 848. Also Balapure & Pandey, 93302.

Ligustrum compactum Hk. f.

Shrub with white flowers. Basali near Almora, Awasthi, 586.

ASCLEPIADACEAE

Asclepias curassavica L.

Tall herb with beautiful scarlet flowers. Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93241.

Hoya lanceolata Wall.

Askot, 1371 m. Osmoston, 3.1.1932 (DD Herb.)

Pergularia pallida W. & A.

A twining shrub with yellowish green flowers. Kapkot-Bageshwar, 1005 m. Awasthi, 980.

GENTIANACEAE

Gentiana pedicellata Wall.

Almora, Wazirgarh, Awasthi, 2438.

CONVOLVULACEAE

Porana racemosa Roxb.

A twining shrub with white flowers. Sama-Kapkot, 1005 m. Srivastava, 689.

SOLANACEAE

Solanum incanum L.

Spinescent shrub with green fruits, mature fruits yellow. Quite common. Jageshwar temple, Artola, Almora. Balapure & Pandey, 93414.

SCROPHULARIACEAE

Lindenbergia macrostachya Benth.

Herb. Common. Bageshwar-Kapkot, 975 m-1066 m. Awasthi, 676. Also Bharari to Loharkhet, 975 m-1066 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93274.

Mazus japonica (Thunb.) Kuntze

Syn. *M. rugosus* Lour.

Herb with pale blue or white flowers. Bageshwar, Kaul & Party, 19322.

Veronica anagallis L.

Herb with purple or white flowers. Near Loharkhet, 1737 m. Awasthi, 701.

Wulfenia amherstiana Benth.

Herb. Flowers drooping, blue purple varying to white. Very common. Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93254.

ACANTHACEAE

Lepidagathis cuspidata Nees

Bageshwar to Kapkot, 1066 m. Awasthi, 701.

LABIATAE

Ajuga parviflora Benth. var. **depressa**

Herb with blue flowers. Near Furkia, 3048 m. Awasthi, 896.

Pogostemon bengalensis (Benth.) O. Ktze.

Takula-Bageshwar, 1219 m. Awasthi, 688.

Roylea elegans Wall.

Shrub. Flowers white tinged with pink. Bageshwar-Kapkot, 1066 m. Awasthi, 677.

Salvia coccinea L.

Kapkot-Bageshwar, Srivastava, 54023.

S. psuedo-coccinea Jacq.

Kapkot-Bageshwar, 1066 m. Awasthi, 986.

Teucrium royaleanum Wall.

Herb. Flowers white. Near Bageshwar, 975 m. Awasthi, 651.

Phlomis bracteosa Royle

Herb with densely hairy stem. Flowers dull blue purple. Very common. Dwali to Kafni, 2743 m-3352 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93328 & 93330.

AMARANTHACEAE

Aerva lanata Juss.

Near Dhakuri, 2438 m, Awasthi, 733.

PHYTOLACCACEAE

Phytolacca acinosa Roxb.

Tall herb with white flowers. Commonly cultivated at Khati. 2225 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93388.

POLYGONACEAE

Polygonum chinense Linn.

Shrub with white or pink flowers. Loharkhet, 1676 m. Awasthi, 922.

P. microcephalum D. Don

Herb with pink flowers. Very common. Phurkia to Khati, along the bank of Pindar river, 3124 m-2286 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93377.

Rumex dentatus Linn.

Herb with greenish flowers. Very common in moist places. Khati to Dwali, on the bank of Pindar river, 2133 m-2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91579. Dr. Rao's record is from Nainital.

LAURACEAE

Machilus gamblei King ex Hook. f.

Medium-sized tree, with yellowish green flowers. Takula-Bageshwar, 1524 m. Awasthi, 635. Vern. "Kaula".

M. duthiei King ex Hook. f.

Tree with pale yellow flowers. Khati-Dwali, 2438 m. Awasthi, 861.

Persea odoratissima (Nees) Kosterm.

Syn. *Machilus odoratissima* Nees

Tree with pale yellow flowers. Loharkhet, 1371 m. Awasthi, 941. Vern. Kaua.

Lindera pulcherrima Bth.

Large tree. Near Khati, 2346 m. Awasthi, 794.

ELAEAGNACEAE

Elaeagnus umbellata Thunb.

Shrub with white flowers. Near Khati, 2316 m. Awasthi, 802. Also from Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 2133 m-2438 m. Awasthi, 742.

LORANTHACEAE

Dendrophthoe falcata (Linn. f.) Etting.

Syn. *Loranthus falcatus* Linn. f. Syn. *Loranthus longiflorus* Desr. var. *falcata*

Parasite on a large tree. Not very common. Between Loharkhet & Dhakuri, Balapure & Pandey, 91544.

EUPHORBIACEAE

Baliospermum axillare Bl.

Shrub near Bageshwar, 914 m. Awasthi, 652.

Sapium sebiferum Roxb.

Small glabrous tree, Takula, 1524 m. Awasthi, 574, Dr. Rao's record is from Bhim Tal 1400 m. which is off the route from Pindari glaciers.

S. insigne Benth.

Small tree. Takula, 6-8 Km from Bageshwar, 1524 m. Awasthi, 643. Vern. Khiro.

Croton tiglium Linn.

Large shrub with white flowers. fruit green. Very common. Bharari to Loharkhet, 1005 m-1828 m., Balapure & Pandey, 93266. Naturalized along the road.

MORACEAE

Ficus roxburghii Wall.

A spreading tree. Takula, 1615 m. Awasthi, 614. Vern. Timula.

F. pubigera Wall.

Askot, 1371 m-1524 m. Awasthi, 854.

F. clavata Wall.

An erect shrub. Takula, 1676 m. Awasthi, 613.

F. carica Linn.

Tree with fruits. Common. Bharari to Loharkhet 1005 m-1828 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93243.

BETULACEAE

Alnus nitida Endl.

Tree. Loharkhet-Dhakuri, 2286 m. Awasthi, 715.

Betula alnoides Buch.-Ham.

Dhakuri-Khati, 2346 m. Awasthi, 800.

SALICACEAE

Salix wallichiana Anders.

Shrub. Near Dwali along river. Awasthi, 913.

CONIFERAE

Abies webbiana Lindl.

Syn. *A. spectabilis* Royle

Tree. Dhakuri hill, 2590 m. Awasthi, 763.

MONOCOTYLEDONS

ORCHIDACEAE

Calanthe tricarinata Lindl.

Flowering stem. Flower sepal and petals green outside, edged with white, pale yellow green inside. Near Khati, 2133 m. Awasthi, 823.

Coelogyne ovalis Lindl.

Baram Gorichal, Askot, No. 1828. 16.10.50.

Luisia inspicua Hk. f.

Bagrihat-Askot, 914 m on mango tree. Awasthi.

Oberonia ensiformis Lindl.

Near Kapkot bridge 1066 m. Awasthi, 937. Although Dr. Rao has mentioned this species, the name of the locality is not given.

SCITAMINEAE

Roscoea alpina Royle

Leafy stem with dark purple flowers. Low herb found on wet-ground Dhakuri, C. E. Parkinson 5996. (DD Herb.) collected on 13th June, 1935.

DIOSCORIACEAE

Dioscorea glabra Roxb.

Climbing plants. Kapkot-Bageshwar. Srivastava 54059.

LILIACEAE

Smilax elegans Wall.

Climbing shrub. Dhakuri hill. 3048 m. Awasthi, 784.

S. glaucophylla Klotzsch.

Syn. *S. parvifolia* Wall.- ex Hook. f.

Climbing shrub. Flowers minute, purple. Kapkot-Loharkhet, 1219 m. Awasthi, 702.

S. macrophylla Roxb.

A large climber with globular fruits. Common. Ranikhet, Balapure & Pandey, 72708.

Trillium govanianum Wall.

A glabrous herb with purple flowers. Dhakuri hill, 2590 m. Awasthi, 758.

JUNCACEAE

Juncus bufonius L.

A small, pale coloured, tufted herb. Bageshwar, 975 m. Kaul & Party, 9269.

ARACEAE

Arisaema curvatum Kunth

A tender herb. Quite common in shade under the Rhododendron tree. Between Loharkhet and Dhakuri, 1828 m-2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91555.

A. wallichianum Hk. f.

Tender herb with beautiful dark green and black hood. Quite common in moist places under Rhododendron. Loharkhet and Dhakuri, 1828 m-2438 m. Balapure & Pandey, 91549 & 91556.

CYPERACEAE

Carex obscura Nees

Kafni Glacier, 3300 m. Bis Ram 2133, collected on 23.6.1933 (DD Herb.).

C. condensata Nees

Near Askot 1219 m. Duthie 6103. Collected on 7.7.1886 (DD Herb.).

Arundinella nepalensis Trin.

Bageshwar, 975 m. Kaul & Party 19264.

Cymbopogon martinii Stapf

Patsali, Almora, 1524 m. Awasthi, 1322.

Chrysopogon montana Trin.

Almora, 2000 m. Awasthi, 1325.

Festuca ovina Linn.

Khati, 2300 m. Awasthi.

Rottboellia exaltata Linn. f.

Askot, 1219 m. Awasthi.

Pyrrosia mannii (Giels) Ching

Very common on trees. Jageshwar, near Artola, Almora 2000 m. Balapure & Pandey, 93405.

Botrychium lanuginosum Wall.

Dhaulchhina hills, Almora, 2000 m. Awasthi, 1374.

Osmunda claytoniana Linn.

Near Khati, Awasthi, 787. Dhakuri hills, Awasthi, 787 & 760.

O. regalis L.

Near Khati, 2300 m. Awasthi. 786.

Deunstadtia appendiculata (Wall.) J. Sm.

Loharkhet-Dhakuri Hill, Awasthi, 734.

Polystichum stimulans Pr.

Khati. 2300 m. Awasthi, 836.

P. squarrosus (D. Don) Fee.

Almora, 9 miles to Takula, Awasthi, 571.

P. aculeatum (L.) Roth.

Khati, 2300 m. Awasthi, 788.

Cyrtomium caryotidum (Wall. ex. Hooker et Grev.) Pr.

Khati, 2300 m. Awasthi, 840.

Woodwardia radicans (L.) Sm.

Almora, 9 miles, Takula, Awasthi, 570. Also Khati. 2300 m. Awasthi 841.
