FOURTH INTERNATIONAL GONDWANA SYMPOSIUM

The IV International Gondwana Symposium (under the auspices of the International Union of Geological Sciences) sponsored by Geological Survey of India will be held at Calcutta in February, 1977. The following sectional topics have been chosen for presentation of papers and discussions:

I—PALAEOGEOGRAPHY

II-GONDWANA FLORA

III—GONDWANA FAUNA

IV—ENVIRONMENT AND ORIGIN OF COAL DEPOSITS

V—GLACIAL DEPOSITS

VI—STRATIGRAPHY OF MARINE AND NON-MARINE GONDWANA DEPOSITS

VII—SEDIMENTOLOGY

VIII—TECTONICS, IGNEOUS ACTIVITY, GEOCHRONOLOGY & STRUCTURAL GEOLOGY.

An integral part of programme will be five or six post-session field trips to areas of special significance to Gondwana geology.

The abstracts of papers (in two copies), not exceeding 200 words, should reach the Chairman, Organizing Committee, IV International Gondwana Symposium, Geological Survey of India by 30th June, 1975. Complete type-written text of each paper (in two copies) together with plates and illustrations, if any, should reach the Chairman before 1st July, 1976.

Division IV: Quaternary Palynology

Division V: Palynological data handling and Methodology

Division VI: Palynology in Medicine, Agriculture, Forestry etc.

Pre-and post-Conference excursions are planned.
